아워오션 콘퍼런스(OOC)는 2014년 미국에서 처음 개최된 이래로, 정부, 국제기구, 글로벌기업, 비정부기구, 학계 등 여러 해양주체들이 모여 인류 공동의 자산인 해양의 중요성을 인식하고, 지속가능한 해양을 위한 국제적 협력을 이끈 논의의 장으로서 그 역할을 훌륭하게 해왔습니다.

국제사회는 OOC를 통해 해양보호구역(MPA) 30 by 30 목표 제시, BBNJ(Biodiversity Beyond National Jurisdiction)와 같은 중요한 국제조약의 비준 추진, IUU(Illegal, Unreported, Unregulated) 어업 근절 노력 등 실질적인 협력방안을 논의하며 해양 분야의 국제협력을 강화했습니다.

더불어, 정부, 국제기구, NGO 등 다양한 주체들이 자발적으로 발표한 1,400억 달러 규모의 2,600여 개의 공약을 이행하면서 세계 각지에서 해양의 보전과 지속가능한 이용에 기여했습니다.

지난 OOC를 계승하여 제10차 아워오션 콘퍼런스가 2025년 4월 28일부터 4월 30일까지 부산 벡스코에서 개최됩니다.

OOC의 10주년을 맞이하여 지난 10여년간의 자발적이고 실천적인 공약의 성과와 우수사례를 공유하고 행동 중심의 국제 협력을 위한 새로운 영감과 동력을 제공할 것입니다.

제10차 OOC에서는 해양보호구역, 해양오염, 지속가능한 어업 등 6개의 기본의제에 대한 논의와 더불어 '해양 디지털'을 특별의제로 정하고, 글로벌 해양문제 해결을 위한 디지털 기술의 활용 방안을 중점적으로 논의할 것입니다. 또한 해양 디지털 및 해운조선 비즈니스 서밋과 관련 특별전시 등 다양한 행사를 통해 우리나라 해양수산업과 전 세계 해양리더들 간의 협력과 교류의 장도 마련할 예정입니다.

The **Our Ocean Conference (OOC)** was first launched under the initiative of the U.S. Department of State in 2014. Since then, it has gradually become a key global platform for dialogue that brings together governments, international organizations, academia, the private sector and NGOs that share a common vision for safeguarding our oceans and taking concrete actions to support this goal.

The OOC has served as a leading forum for the international community to strengthen cooperation on ocean sustainability. It has facilitated discussions on practical solutions, such as the establishment of the 30 by 30 target for Marine Protected Areas (MPA), the advancement of the ratification of the High Seas Treaty (BBNJ Agreement) and global efforts to combat Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated (IUU) fishing.

Furthermore, the OOC has mobilized more than 2,600 voluntary commitments from diverse stakeholders, with a collective value approximately USD 140 billion. These commitments have significantly contributed to conservation and sustainable use of the oceans worldwide.

Building on the achievements of previous OOCs, the **10th OOC will take place from April 28 to 30, 2025, at BEXCO in Busan, Republic of Korea.**

Marking its 10th anniversary, the OOC will highlight the accomplishments and exemplary practices of voluntary commitments made over the past decade. It will inspire greater global momentum toward ambitious and action-driven ocean governance.

The 10th OOC will feature discussions on six key areas of action, including Marine Protected Areas, Marine Pollution, and Sustainable Fisheries, with a special focus on “Digital Oceans”. This special agenda will explore how digital technologies can be leveraged to address pressing ocean challenges.

In addition, the conference will offer unique opportunities for collaborative exchange between Korea’s marine and fisheries industries and global ocean leaders through insightful events, including the Digital Ocean Summit, the Green Shipping and Shipbuilding Summit, and special exhibitions.



Our Ocean Conference

Overview of OOC

What is OOC?

The OOC is a high-level international conference held annually, where global ocean leaders gather to address ocean issues and announce action-driven commitments (The “Davos of the Oceans”).

- First held by the United States in 2014, followed by Chile (2nd), the United States (3rd), the EU & Malta (4th), Indonesia (5th), Norway (6th), Palau (7th), Panama (8th), and Greece (9th)

Who Attends?

The OOC is joined by government representatives from over 100 countries, more than 400 NGOs, businesses, international organizations and other stakeholders.

What is Discussed?

The OOC focuses on six key areas of action under a unified slogan, with one special agenda selected by the host country.

How is it Structured?

The OOC features opening and closing ceremonies, panel discussions, commitment announcements and side events*.

*Side events are voluntarily organized by participants. If there are many side event applications, the host country will review and select them.

What Makes it Special?

The OOC catalyzes ambitious actions with active participation and the voluntary commitments*.

*By the 9th OOC (April 2024, Greece), over 2,600 commitments, valued at approximately USD 140 billion, have been announced.

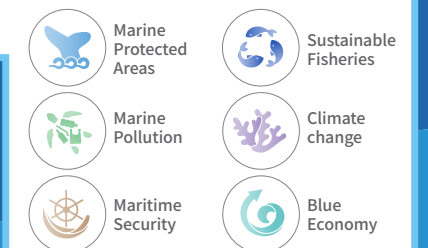
